Therefore the knowledge and common sense of the haulier and drivers, and the need to take responsibility for their own actions is paramount.


How can the drivers help themselves:-

 - Required for the environment or the site
 - Required for the task
 - Required for additional risks identified by the driver
- Use the appropriate equipment









- Ensure the driver has the correct equipment and Personal Protection Equipment
- Support the driver when he challenges or reports something wrong
- Manage his performance when he does something wrong

It is only through a <u>combined approach</u> between the <u>site</u>, the <u>loading</u> <u>teams</u>, the <u>driver</u> and the <u>haulier</u> that we can <u>achieve a safe working</u> environment for all.
