## Driver Injury – Fall whilst closing sliding roof

#### What Happened:

•Approximately 1200hrs – A sub contractor haulier was attempting to close his trailer roof from floor level on a exterior loading bay apron.

•Whilst undertaking this activity he states his hand slipped from the roof pole causing him to twist and fall to the ground.

•The fall resulted in a fractured left ankle.



#### Findings:

• The IP had hooked his roof pole onto the wire release cord which is the INCORRECT method

- Floor surface is concrete and is in good condition
- Full PPE was worn, anti slip boots and roof pole in good condition.
- IP had driven the trailer outside onto the apron outside the loading bay.

#### •Actions:

✓ Only pull on roof using the proper tabs, **NEVER PULL ROOF CLOSED USING RELEASE CORD!!** 

✓Trailer had ropes and straps attached to release cord and roof struts. Although not the cause in this incident, any ropes or straps connected to the roof or release cord MUST BE REMOVED immediately
