## **DEFENSIVE DRIVING**

Recent Road Traffic Accidents showed us even skilled and professional drivers can be involved in Road Traffic Accidents. Accidents happen in just a split second.

The following underlying hazards were or are suspected to be the cause of the recent Road Traffic Accidents;

- **Fatigue;** having negative effect on the response time.
- **Distance**; not keeping sufficient distance.
- Weather conditions; not enough consideration for conditions like slippery roads and limited view.
- **Traffic**; Not anticipating enough to others in traffic, too late to respond to avoid collision and unaware of others in blind spot.
- **Distraction;** By devices like smart phones, navigation systems or other examples such as reading documents.
