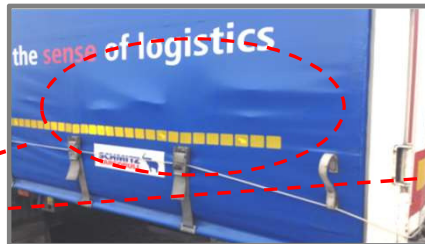


Collecting loaded trailers & Containers and En Route Checks

It is every drivers responsibility to ensure the load he is collecting is secured and in a condition that will not be a hazard to other persons or road users. A basic check must be completed with every collection and again en route to the delivery point, and ALWAYS after any heavy braking event. **If the trailer is sealed, ask your Traffic Office for guidance before breaking the seal.**

1. Look at the trailer



Any lumps or bumps?

If yes: **DO NOT OPEN – report to Operations**



If no:

2. Open the curtains and doors.

Look at the load - note it's position, how it's secured



3. Check the straps

Tighten all the ratchets ensuring they are secure, according to product type



4. Close up curtains and doors



5. Check the load on route and

ALWAYS after a heavy braking event!
Report any problems immediately!
