Driver injury from falling pallet

What Happened:


Driver arrived at the delivery point. He opened the first door. Driver checked and listened for signs of movement. Driver then opened second door. A pallet fell and landed on the driver hitting his head and then leg. Driver was taken to hospital. He is awaiting an operation on his ankle, which is broken.





Findings:


- The rear double-stacked pallets were secured with a strap through the base of the top pallet.
- At some point in transit the pallet had moved and was leaning against the door.



Recommendations:

Drivers and Hauliers should:-

- ✓ Apply 2 straps as cross straps from one side, over the top and then down to the other-side of the trailer. Repeat for the other-side.
- ✓ When on a loading dock, this should be done using access steps and not by climbing.



- ✓ Before opening rear doors of loaded trailers, drivers should:-
 - 1. Remove the seal and TIR cord
 - 2. Loosen the buckles of the curtain near the doors to check if there is signs of movement
 - 3. Carefully open the first door, standing at the end of the door, looking at the product and being prepared to move clear
 - 4. Check the load behind the second door and carefully open the first door, standing at the end of the door, looking at the product and being prepared to move clear
